Resolution

Where as we the members of Lebanon Engine
 Co. 7. Relizing the fact that the Fire Protection
 for the City is inefficient for the safety and
 best interest of the City, and relizing the
 fact that over 85% of the fires in the
 Cities as well as in the Salt Town are
 extinguished by Hook and Ladder Equipmen-
 ts. We would therefore ask the Hon.
 City Council to Purchase a Village
 Hook and Ladder outfit for the use of
 the Fire Department.
