

Lebanon, Or., Dec. 20th 1904
 Council Called to Order by Mayor B. Bucken-
 show

Roll call showed all city officials
 present except Councilman Kellershuger
 and City Attorney Hartman.

Minutes of previous meeting read
 and approved.

The request of the Fire Department
 to the City to purchase Hook and Ladder
 Truck for the City was by motion referred
 to committee on ways & means

The Report of the Mayor and City Recorder
 as Curator of the City Election held in and
 for the City of Lebanon, Or., Dec. 5th 1904

Was read and on motion ordered placed
 on file and City Recorder instructed to
 issue the Proper Certificates of Election
 to the newly elected City officials,

Ordinance Bill 63 was presented
 asking for a franchise for the Rock Hill
 Farmers Mutual Telephone Company was
 present and read after being filed by the
 City Recorder.

Ordinance Bill was read by direction
 of the Mayor

There being no objections offered
 upon the first reading of the Bill

The Mayor stated that the Bill
 might be read the second time now
 by title only, By unanimous consent

Upon the Question shall the Bill
 be read the second time by title only

The Council Voted as follows

on motion it was ordered that the
Property owner be notified to build
new walk as asked for
