

Lebanon Or. Oct-3<sup>rd</sup> 1905

Council called to order by Mayor B. Burtchard  
Roll call showed all City officials  
present except, Councilman Scroggin, &  
Councilman Herrick, and City attorney,  
Minutes of previous meeting read  
and approved.

3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report of City Recorder  
and City Treasurer read and referred to  
Committee on accounts and current  
expenses.

City Marshal was instructed to ascertain  
the location of all sidewalks in bad  
condition and report next regular Meeting  
J. H. Halt tendered his resignation as  
Deputy City Marshal on motion of B. A.

Millsap duly made and carried the  
resignation of J. H. Halt was accepted  
On motion of B. A. Millsap duly made  
and carried J. G. Green was chosen as Deputy  
City Marshal.

On motion of B. A. Millsap  
Councilman S. R. Claypool Chairman of  
Committee on streets and Public property  
was authorized by the City Council to  
have all places in the streets in bad  
condition fixed.

On Motion of B. A. Millsap  
J. G. Green salary for acting as Deputy City  
was fixed at, \$35<sup>00</sup> per month.  
City Marshal Grant Lindley tendered  
his resignation as City Marshal of  
the City of Lebanon

On Motion of B. A. Millsap and  
seconded by J. B. Springer, The resignation of  
Grant Lindley as City Marshal was  
accepted.

On Motion duly made and carried  
the City Council reconsidered the vote  
of electing J. G. Green deputy City Marshal  
and Elected J. G. Green City Marshal  
for the unexpired term of Mr Lindley.

On Motion of B. A. Millsaps the  
Marshals Salary was fixed at \$40<sup>00</sup>  
per Month.
