

Lebanon Or. Nov. 7th 1905

Council called to order by Mayor B. Burtushaw
Roll call showed all City officials
present except Councilman F. Murick and
City Marshal.

Minutes of previous meeting read and
corrected and approved as corrected.

On motion the Chairman of the Committee
on Streets & Public Property was instructed
and empowered have gravel placed at cross
walks needing the same.

Bond of J. R. Green as City Treasurer
was read and on motion duly made
and carried approving the same, which
was ordered filed by the City Recorder

Deed from P. M. Scroggin wife to the City
of Lebanon, for a strip of Land for street
purpose was read, and on motion duly
made and carried, was accepted and
ordered sent to record.

The side ^{walk} question as to compelling property-
owners to build new walks and closing lines
on the Real property for the Building of the
same by the City, was by motion left till
next Regular Meeting and the City Recorder
asked to bring line Books at next regular
Meeting.

Councilman Springer asked the
City Council for the use of 150 feet of Fire
Hose to test New fire pump at Paper
Mill, on motion the request was granted.

On Motion City attorney Garland was
appointed a committee of one to ascertain
what the City could get an official
Map of Lebanon for, and report next
Meeting.
