

Lebanon Or. Dec. 5<sup>th</sup> 1905

Council called to Order by Mayor B. Rustenhaus  
Roll call showed all the City Council  
present, also City Recorder and City Marshal  
Minutes of Nov. 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> read and  
approved as read.

Mr Henderson representing the  
Rock Hill Farmers Mutual Telephone  
Company asked the City Council the privi-  
lege to sell an equal interest in their  
Switch Board to users of the same,

ON Motion the City Council Voted  
unanimously signifying their willingness to  
to the company to sell the interest as asked  
for, and referred the same to the Ordinance  
Committee to have an amendment  
to Ordinance prepared and present the  
same to Council for passage.

Bogart and Stum presented Petition to  
City Council asking the City Council to  
cause to be passed an Ordinance allow-  
ing the Riding of Bicycles on the Side  
Walks, by proper restrictions,

Committee on accounts and Current  
Expenses reported that they had examined  
the Reports of the City Treasurer and City  
Recorder for 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarterly Report and  
found the same correct.

The Petition of Bogart and Stum was  
referred to Ordinance Committee.

Millsap and Son asked the City  
Council permission to put in Hitch  
Racks on Grant Street between 2<sup>nd</sup> and  
Main Street, ON Motion the same  
was granted.

The degree of Honor asked to rent the  
Citys Hall for meetings ON motion the

On Motion the Pacific States Telephone & Telegraph Co. was ordered to Paint their Poles in the City which was not already Painted in a reasonable time

On Motion the former Motion was rescinded.

On Motion of J. B. Spruigert seconded by S. R. Claypool duly carried The City Recorder was instructed to Notify the Pacific States Telephone and Telegraph Co to Paint all unpainted Poles inside the City Limits as provided for by their Franchise within 20 days from date of notice or else remove the same out of the streets in said time

On Motion the City Recorder was requested to notify the New Elected Officers of the City that the retiring officers would expect a Banquet on night of installation of City Officers.
