Minutes of last regular meeting read and approved.

Petition of Citizens of Grove Street asking the Council to establish lights on that street from Olive Street northward. The Paper Mill was granted and the following resolution was adopted. That the City Electric Light Co.

by directed to put in position at one  
four 16 candle inconducent lights as  
prayed for in the petition of L. D. Waddell  
and others. The Council then passed the  
following resolution levying a tax for 1907.

Whereas, it is necessary that money be  
raised by taxation, for the general expenses  
of the City of Lebanon, Lincoln County, Oregon, and  
likewise for the improvement, construction  
and repair of the Roads and Streets of  
said City.

Now therefore be it resolved:

That the City Council of the City of Lebanon  
aforesaid in regular meeting assembled  
on the 18th day of December 1906, do hereby  
make a levy of 7 Mills on the one  
dollar for general City purposes and the  
further levy of 3 Mills on the one dollar  
for Road and Street purposes, on all  
the property within said City, by law  
assessable upon the valuation of said  
property, as shown by the assessment  
roll of 1906, now on file in the  
office of the County Clerk of said  
County, said levy being for the year  
1907. and, further, that the City Council  
aforesaid do hereby vote and make a  
levy of the sum of two upon each  
male inhabitant of said City, between  
the age of twenty one and fifty years  
except those exempt by law, that the  
City records be made and transmitted, in  
mediately, to the County Clerk, a true and  
due notice of the levy made at this time.

This is to certify, that this resolution  
was adopted by the City Council of Lebanon  
County Oregon this 18th day of Dec. 1906.
