Council met in regular session with Mayor S. T. Bach in the chair and all other officers present except Councilman Powell and Tras Kirkpatrick.

Minutes of last regular and special meeting read and approved.

Communication from the American Light and Water Co. of Kas. City read and placed on file.

The Committee on Ordinance was instructed to draw up an Ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 5 relating to Licensing Pool Rooms.

The Street Committee was authorized to get lumber and repair the Bridge at the School house and the one across the waste ditch at the Sawmill.

The Marshal authorized to sell sidewalk Lumber to Mr. David Andrews for his walk.

The Marshal was instructed to confer with parties owning shade trees along street and have them prune their trees so people could carry an umbrella under them.

The Marshal was also instructed to notify parties having manure or rubbish in the alleys adjacent to their property, to move it away.

The City Atty. was instructed to get the Initiator and Referendum Law in working order.
