Council called to order by Mayor S. P. Bach  
 Roll call showed the following officers present  
 Mayor S. P. Bach, Councilmen J. M. Crandall,  
 C. Greer, J. C. Mayer, and C. H. Palston, Recorder  
 G. Lobelee, Marshall, A. M. Wilson and City  
 Attorney N. M. Newport, Absent, Councilmen  
 C. Bogart, and F. M. Powell, Treasurer H. J. Kirkpatrick  
 and Health Officer Dr. F. J. Laird.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved  
 Under head of New Business.

The City Marshall was instructed to notify  
 the <sup>officer of the</sup> School District to take the Barbed Wire off  
 the fence around the Academy ground recently  
 put up. Also to notify the said Board to Build  
 a regulation <sup>side</sup> walk on the East side of the Academy lot  
 commencing at a point on West Side of Main Street  
 at the South East Corner of the Academy lot  
 continuing on the West side of Main Street to the  
 North East Corner of said lot, thence West on the  
 North side said lot as far West as Main Street  
 goes, Also said Marshall to notify the property owners  
 along the following described route, to repair these  
 side walks, commencing at the South East Corner  
 of the late A. M. Powell's property on the West side  
 of Main Street as far North as Frank Maister,  
 thence commencing at South West Corner of J. M.  
 Burtenshaw, property, continuing on the North side  
 of Main Street to the East side of Main Street side walk,  
 thence continuing on the said East side Main Street  
 to the South West Corner of H. E. Snyder's property.  
 Whereas, It is necessary that money be raised by  
 taxation for the general expenses of the City  
 of Lebanon, Lin County, Oregon, and likewise

for the improvement, construction and repairs  
of the Roads and streets of said City.  
and upon Motion made and carried ~~that~~ a levy  
of 4 Mills on the Dollar be made on all city  
assessable property divided as follows  $4\frac{1}{2}$  Mill <sup>on the one dollar,</sup> for general  
fund and  $1\frac{1}{2}$  Mill for streets and roads and that  
the Recorder be instructed to so notify the County  
Clerk for Linn County Oregon.
