

City Council Chamber
 Lebanon, Oct Dec 30th - 1907

Council met in adjourned session.
 The Mayor S. P. Bach in the Chair.
 Roll called showed all officers present.

Communication read: letter from Merrill Oden asking for a copy of the new Charter, was turned over to City Attorney R. M. Newport for him to send a copy of the new Lebanon Charter.

Under the head of new Business.

Dr. C. Cheadle, was present and complained about the South End of ^{Mad} Street near to the School House ^{be very dark} and on motion the street committee was instructed to see Mr Hughes regarding the matter.

It was moved, second, and carried, by request from the S. P. R. R. Co. that they be given until the 1st day of April 1908 before commencing to build the new depot, and that Councilman J. C. Mayer be instructed to notify Mr Ford the Agent, to that effect.

* Resignation of A. M. Wilson City Marshall was read, and on motion being made his resignation was accepted to take effect Dec 30th - 1907.

Moved and carried that Phil Ritter be elected to fill out the unexpired term of City Marshall A. M. Wilson.

 and so far no other ^{fresh} cases add broke out.
