Lebanon, Ore. Dec 20-1907

Council met in special called meeting
with Mayor S. P. Bach in the Chair

Roll Call showed all Officers present.

Moved, seconded and carried that the
Tax Levy made on the 17th day of Dec 1907
be rescinded.

Resolution Fixing Tax Levy for 1908

Whereas, it is necessary that money and revenue
be raised by general taxation for the general
expenses of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Ore.
and for the improvement and repair of
the streets and cross walks of said city
for the year 1908, and the current
expenses of the said City.

Now therefore be it resolved that the
City Council of the said City of Lebanon,
Linn County, Oregon, in a special meeting
duly and legally called and held in the said
City on the 20th day of December, 1907, the
Mayor being in the chair, and all members
of the council being present, do hereby and by
this resolution make and fix the levy of
4½ mills on the one dollar for general City
purposes and the further levy of 1½ mills
on the one dollar for road, street and cross walk
purposes on all the taxable property within
said city by law assessable upon the valuation
of the said property as shown by the County
assessment roll for the year 1907, now

on file with The County Clerk of the said
Lincoln County Oregon the said levy being for
the year 1908.

And be it further resolved, by the said
Council that the said City Council do hereby
vote and make a levy of the sum of Two
Dollars upon each and every male resident
and inhabitant within the said city of
Sebanon Lincoln County Oregon, between the ages
of 21 and 50 years, except those who are by
general laws exempt, from said Tax.

Be it further resolved that the Recorder
of the City of Sebanon make and transmit
to the Clerk of Lincoln County immediately
due notice of this levy.

This is to Certify that this resolution
was adopted by the City Council of Sebanon
Lincoln County Oregon, on this the 2nd day of Dec 1907
