Lebanon Sept 15 - 1908

Council called to order by Mayor J. C. Mayer

Roll call showed all officers present with the exception of Treasurer S. J. Kirkpatrick and Health officer L. M. Jones.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Ordinance Bill No 86 Ordinance 824

was introduced and there being no objection offered the Bill was then read the first time.

There being no objection offered upon the first reading of the Bill, The Mayor stated the Bill might be read the second time now by title only, upon the calling of the roll the vote was as follows.

### New Business

On motion being made, duly seconded and carried, F. J. Powell, H. C. Heyhaver, and C. H. Ralston, was appointed a committee to meet the Officers of the S. C. & W. Co. to make a contract with the City of Lebanon for water, said contract to be submitted to the City Council for their approval. The City Attorney was instructed to notify the S. P. R. R. Co. to open up the Streets as per Contract. The City Attorney was instructed to notify the property owners to put in regulation side walks on the East side of Third Street, between Sherman and Grant Streets, also to notify the property owners on the North side of Grant Street between Main and Third Street to put in a 8ft side walk on the North side of Grant Street.

The following Bills having been O. H. D. by the committee on account of current expences, was read and on motion allowed, and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer, to pay the same.
