lay on table until next meeting.

New Business

Jess Smith was granted permission to have
a wire strung from J. C. Devine's to the Opera
House for 60 days.

L. L. Peterson was present to ask the Council
to have a side walk built to his place, and on
motion it was referred to street committee.

City Attorney H. M. Newport ^{instructed} to take proper steps
about building a side walk on the East side of
Second Street on the Hindman Property.

City Attorney was instructed to notify
C. Spurling and J. W. Vrehart to move their fences
back to their proper line.

Mrs S. O. Wallace to be notified to put her side walk
back to proper line within ten days.

City Attorney was instructed to notify those parties
who had been already notified to have their Water
Spouts fixed at once.
