

City Council Chambers,  
Lebanon Dec 1<sup>st</sup> 1908

Council called to order by Mayor J. C. Mayer.

Roll call showed all officers present with the exception of Councilman C. H. Green and Treasurer W. J. Fitzpatrick.

Minutes read and approved.

Ordinance Bill No 89 Ordinance No 85 was introduced and there being no objection offered the Bill was then read the first time, there being no objection offered to the first reading of the Bill, The Mayor stated that the bill might be read the second time now by title only, upon the calling of the Roll the vote was as follows, (yes) J. M. Crandall, J. R. Green, N. D. Heehaver, C. H. Palston, J. C. Powell, The Bill was then read the second time by title only.

"Thereupon The Mayor Stated"

This is the second reading of the Ordinance Bill it is now ready for Commitment or amendment, in order for a third reading when upon motion being made and duly seconded, that the Bill be read the third time the calling of the roll showed that the vote was as follows, (yes) J. M. Crandall, J. R. Green, N. D. Heehaver, C. H. Palston, J. C. Powell, Thereupon The Mayor stated:

 The Mayor then declared the title of the Bill  
 to be the title of the Ordinance.  
 The Bill was then approved by the Mayor  
 and attested by the City Recorder.

Resolution No. 1. Relating to Construction of  
 a Regulation side walk on lot 8 Block 2. was  
 introduced <sup>by C. H. Ralston</sup> and on motion being made duly seconded  
 and carried was adopted, and ordered placed  
 on file,

The Ordinance committee was instructed to  
 to prepare an ordinance, for the protection  
 of Electric Light & Water Co. Telephone <sup>Co.</sup> or any other  
 company property, who the city as granted them  
 power to construct within the City limits.

City Attorney was instructed to notify. R. P.  
 Blackburn to build a regulation side walk  
 on the East side of his property west of the  
 R. R. Track at once,

On Motion being made duly carried, The Arc light  
 near to the Depot was ordered to be moved to the  
 center of Third and Sherman Street,  
 it was also ordered that two incandescents lights  
 be placed at 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> and Grant Street,

C. Galbraith was to be instructed to build a  
 regulation side walk within 30 days on the  
 North side of his property on Isabella Street,

On Motion being made duly seconded and  
 carried S. M. Garland was retained as adviser  
 for the City.

The following Bills having been O. K. by the  
 committee on account of current expenses was read  
 and allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the  
 Treasurer to pay the same, General Fund of Richards \$50.<sup>00</sup>  
 Street and Road, J. C. Gainer, \$2.<sup>00</sup> A. Mentze \$16.<sup>15</sup>  
 on Motion Council adjourned. C. J. Miller
