On Motion being made duly seconded and carried, it was decided to accept the offer of James Johnson, and B. Irwin for \$100.<sup>00</sup> for the purchase of land on William Street for improvement of said street, providing B. Irwin will deed the Rod of land on Dodge Street, running East and West.
