Council met in special called meeting with Mayor, J. C. Mayer, in the chair.

Roll call showed all officers present.

~~Resolution Fixing Tax Levy of the City of Lebanon for 1909.~~

Whereas, it is necessary that money be raised by general taxation for the general expenses of the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, and for the improvement of the streets and the repair of streets and cross walks and other improvements of the said city for the year 1909, and for the current expenses of the said city for said year, and to pay interest on outstanding warrants and to pay indebtedness of the said City;

Now therefore be it resolved that the common Council of the said City in special session of the said Council duly called and held in the Council chambers of the said City on the 18 day of December, 1908, the Mayor being in the chair and a quorum of the members of the council being present do hereby and by this resolution make and fix the levy of $8\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the one dollar for general purposes of the said City and $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the one dollar for road and street purposes and for crosswalk purposes on all the taxable property in the said City upon the valuation of the said property as shown by the County assessment roll for the year 1908 now on file with the County Clerk of Linn County, Oregon, the said levy being for the year 1909.

And be it further resolved by the said Council, that the City Recorder of the City of Lebanon, transmit immediately to the Clerk of Linn County, Oregon, due notice of this Levy.
