Council called to order by Mayor, J. C. Mayer.

Roll call showed all officers present with the exception of Treasurer H. Y. Kirkpatrick.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Petition presented by Fire Chief W. C. Peterson was presented for a Chemical Engine, and on motion accepted and ordered placed on file.
