Lebanon, Oct 19-1909-

## New Business.

The following Gentlemen was present in the interest of a new City Hall, Mr. A. Miller, Bert Milloyp, Professor Benner, Morgan, G. Epperley, G. Buhl, Herm, and Dr. J. G. Gill, and after a general talk by the visitors and the Council in regards the building of a new City Hall, when a motion was made duly seconded, roll call was asked for the following answers to these names, (yes) J. R. Green, R. D. Heefhader, C. H. Ralston, W. C. McClain, J. L. Underwood, thereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and proper steps to be taken to build a new City Hall not to exceed.

The letter of S. P. R. R. Co. accepting Ordinance No 93 was ordered returned for the date of acceptance upon it.

The Ordinance Committee was instructed to prepare the following Ordinances to wit: an Ordinance limit and Ordinances to do away with the <sup>wooden</sup> sawings on the streets and present them to the Council at their next regular meeting.

A new regulation side walk was ordered to be built at once, on the South side of Grant Street, between Fourth and Fifth Streets. The water way in the front of J. C. Arnolds was ordered to be fixed under the supervision of the Street Commissioners.

The following Bills having being O. H. O. by the Committee on Current expence was read and allowed and on motion warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer, to pay the same, L. C. L. & W. Co. \$168<sup>50</sup>, Jerome Smith \$274<sup>28</sup>, C. H. Ralston \$607<sup>50</sup>, (A. Mentze \$52<sup>30</sup>),
