

City Council Chambers
Lebanon (December 7th 1909)

Council called to order by Mayor J. C. Mayer

Roll call showed all officers present with the exception of Treasurer H. Y. Kirkpatrick and Health officer Dr. W. W. Ginnell.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved

The special committee appointed by the Mayor at the regular meeting of the Council on Nov 16-1909 reported favorably in regard to the purchasing the 21 ft strip ^{the South side} on Elmore. It offered to the City by the Lebanon Paper Co.

Ordinance Bill No 98 Ordinance No 94 and Ordinance Bill No 99 Ordinance No 93 was brought up for Third reading, when all Councilmen voted for the Bill and finally passed, all Councilmen voting in favor of it. The final passage, and approved by the Mayor on the 8th day of Dec 1909 and attested by the Recorder.

Ordinance Bill No 100 Ordinance No 96 was read the first time without opposition also second time by title only. all members of the Council with the exception of Mr. S. Shephard, voting for the third and final passage, and approved by the Mayor on the 8 day of Dec 1909. and attested by the City Recorder same date

Correspondence read and on Motion ordered placed on file.

New Business

After a general discussion in respect to putting a cross walk from the Hotel Lebanon to the Post office, roll call was asked for, resulting as follows, (No) S. M. Grandall, C. H. Ralston, W. O. McElain, (yes) J. R. Green, H. D. Speyhar, J. L. Underwood, it being a tie the Mayor Casting is vote No, it was therefore lost.

After a general discussion in respect to buying the 21 ft strip of land from the Lebanon Paper Co on the South side of Elmore street, and it ~~not~~ being a question whether there is any street further East than the Lebanon Paper Co. and G. L. Alexander's properties, no action was taken in the matter.

Upon Motion being made duly seconded and carried the judges and Clerk's ~~fees~~ the City Election Held on the 6th day of Dec 1909, was ordered to be paid of \$2⁵⁰ each and the three appraisers to be paid of \$2⁰⁰ each and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer to pay the the same.

Morgan for full amount to pay other Clerks and judges.
