 build and operate a Railroad was
 introduced and on Motion read
 and duly seconded the Bill passed
 the first and second reading
 on Motion read and duly seconded
 the Council was appointed Jas A Hale
 to meet Tuesday Oct 19^{a committee} to go over the ground
 and investigate the route and examine
 the Bill and report at the adjourned
 meeting Oct 21

on Motion read and duly seconded
 the Council adjourned to meet
 Friday night Oct 21
