Council met in a regular meeting
 Mayor C M Rivers presided in the chair
 Roll Call showed all members of the Council
 present except Councilman J L Underwood
 minutes of previous meeting read and approved
 Application from R Duhn for license to run
 a skating rink was introduced and read and on
 motion was referred to license committee
 on Motion the City Attorney and Recorder was
 entrusted to give ^{the} S. P. Railway Co notice
 to repair crossing and side walk crossing on
 William Street

Resolution No 10

1911 Whereas heretofore and on the 4th day of August
 the Committee on Streets and public property of
 the Common Council of the city of Lebanon
 signed and issued to S P Bach a permit
 in writing allowing certain changes to be made
 in the building situated at the South East corner
 of Main Sherman Streets in the city of Lebanon
 Oregon and whereas the said Committee
 has this day made a report in writing to
 this Council to the effect and in substance

That the said committee signed and issued the said permit under a misapprehension of the facts and that the said committee have since ascertained that the costs of the said changes will exceed the maximum limit allowed by law and the ordinance of the said city and will cost more than 25 per cent of the total value of the said building and increase the fire risk, and that the same should not be permitted and the said changes should not be made and whereas no work has been done and no expense incurred by reason of the issuing of the said permit and no charges have yet been made in the said buildings

Therefore now be it resolved that the said permit be suspended and as the said S P Bach be and he is hereby required to show cause at the next meeting of the Council to be held on the 29th day of August 1911 at 8 o'clock P.M. of said day why the said permit should not be revoked and if the said S P Bach does not at the said time appear and show cause why the same should not be revoked that the same stand revoked and annulled and held for naught in as much as the safety and peace of the city requires that this resolution be in effect at once an emergency is hereby declared and this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor

Passed by the Council this 15th day of August 1911 on motion the petition now on file asking for an ordinance permitting the riding of bicycles on side walks was referred to the ordinance committee to report at next regular meeting

on motion Council adjourned to meet Wednesday evening Aug 16th
