Lebanon, Oregon, Council Chambers, August 29, 1911. Council

Council met in regular session, in the City Council Chambers, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., that being the time and place for the regular meeting of the Council, with Mayor A. M. Reeves in the chair and presiding. The roll called, showed all members elected to the Council present and in their places.

The affidavits of the publication for the sale of sewer bonds were filed with the Recorder by the Lebanon Express and the Lebanon Criterion, showing the said notice had been published for three full weeks, by being published four times in the weekly issues of the said papers.

Bids were received and opened for the purchase of the said bonds as follows: -

- (1) The Union Trust and Savings Bank of Spokane Washington, the par value of the bonds and accrued interest and \$2.70 on the One Thousand Dollar premium, and the furnish of lithographed bonds free.
- (2) J. H. Causey & Co. of Denver, Colorado, the face value of the bonds and accrued interest, and Seventy-five Dollar gross premium on the Seventy Thousand Dollar issue and to furnish blank bonds free.
- (3) Bidwell & Hayden Bros. of Portland, Oregon, the par value for an amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars of the bonds.

The Council adjourned until Thursday night, August 31st, 1911, to consider the bids.
