

Sebanon Oregon Sep 5<sup>th</sup> 1911  
 Council Met in a regular session  
 in the City Council Chambers that being  
 the time and place for the regular meeting  
 of the Council

With Mayor C M Reeves in the Chair  
 Roll Call showed all members of the Council  
 present except Councilman J S Northrup.  
 Minutes of previous meetings read and approved  
 as read

Petition from Frank Henry and others asking  
 for an art light on Sherman Street west of  
 the rail road was read

and on motion was accepted and ordered placed  
 on file

ordinance Bill No 112 ordinance 108

An ordinance declaring assessment and fixing  
 a lien for sidewalk improvements on lots  
 5, 6, 7 and 8 in Block No 5 in Warsaw addition,  
 to Sebanon,

was introduced by <sup>the</sup> ordinance committee and  
 read the first time.

There was no objection offered on the first reading  
 of the ordinance

Thereupon the Mayor stated that the Bill might  
 be read the second time <sup>now</sup> by title only

upon the calling of the Roll the vote was as follows  
 (yes) J M Randall W C McClain J L Underwood  
 C H Ralston B L Cotton

The Bill was then read the second time by title  
 only

Thereupon the Mayor stated  
 This is the second reading of the ordinance  
 Bill it is now ready for commitment or  
 amendment in order for the third reading  
 upon motion being made and duly seconded  
 that the Bill be read the third time now and  
 placed on its final passage.

The calling of the Roll showed the vote as follows

 C H Ralston B L Cotton

The Bill was then read the third time.

The Mayor then stated

The Mayor then stated

Shall the title of the Bill stand as the title of the ordinance

(yes) upon the Roll being called the vote was as follows  
J M Randall W C McLain J L Underwood  
C H Ralston B L Cotton

The Mayor then declared the title of the Bill to be the title of the ordinance

on Motion Marshal Frank Richards was granted a leave of absence for three weeks and Geo Childs be appointed to fill his vacancy.

The Mayor appointed C H Ralston & J L Underwood a Committee, to see about securing a place for the Council to meet; and report at the next meeting.

The Committee on Health and Police was entrusted to investigate the condition of the City Hall, and the building belonging to Mr Lovengood, now occupied by W M Brown as a produce house, situated on the East side of Main Street between Grant and Maple Streets

on Motion the City Attorney was entrusted to commence proceedings to have new side walks built as ordered by the Council, on all property where the time has expired
