Council met in a regular ^{adjourned} meeting Mayor A M Reeves being in the chair

minutes of previous meeting read and approved
Roll call showed all members of the Council present except Councilmen J M Randall J L Underwood Geo Brown was present and asked the Council to not proceed any farther with the matter of building new sidewalk on the East side of his property on Second Street on motion the matter of building new sidewalks was referred to the Committee on Streets and public Property moved by Councilman C H Ralston and duly seconded that the weekly proceedings of the Recorder be published in the news papers of the city.

on motion the Recorder was entrusted to furnish the night watch with a list of small lights to be furnished by the Light and Water Co to the city free of charge and the place where the lights are to be placed

on motion the marshal was entrusted to notify the proprietors of the Palm restaurant to clean up the rubbish on the back end of the property and fill up seepool at once
Communication from the Ladies Civic Club asking the Council to assist in the purchase of a 25 acre tract of land of L D Lumberking for a city park was read and on motion the matter was referred to the Council as a whole to investigate

on motion the mayor was entrusted to supply Mrs Garvin and children with the necessary provisions to live on till next regular meeting of the Council

on motion A P Blackburn was ordered to build new sidewalk on the South side of Grant Street between fifth ~~and~~ 5th fifth and 6th Sixth Street on the north side lots 1-2-3-4 and 5 in block 6 Six
