Resolution No 14

Fixing the tax levy of the city of Sebanon Linn County Oregon for the year 1912

introduced by committee on ways and means

Whereas it is necessary that money be raised by general taxation for the general expenses of the city of Sebanon, Linn County, Oregon and to pay interest on the bonded indebtedness of the said city and for the improvement and repair of streets and crosswalks in the said city and for other improvements and other necessary expenses of the said city for the year 1912 and for the current expenses of the said city for the said year 1912 and to pay the unbonded indebtedness of the said city

Now therefore be it Resolved that the Common Council of the said city of Sebanon, Linn County, Oregon in and at a special meeting and session of the said Council duly called and held in the Council Chambers on the 19th day of December 1911 Mayor A M Reeves being in the chair and presiding and all members of the Council being present and in their places and voting does hereby and by this resolution does make and fix the tax levy of $8\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the one dollar for general purposes and sewer fund interest of the said city and $1\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the one dollar for roads and streets and crosswalk purposes in the said city, upon the valuation of all taxable property in the said city on the valuation as given and shown by the assessment roll of Linn County Oregon, for ~~the~~ ^{said} city for the year 1911

now on file with the County Clerk of and for said
 Linn County Oregon, this ^{is} being for the year
 1912

and be it further resolved by the Council that the City
 Recorder of the city of Lebanon Oregon transmit immediately
 to the clerk of Linn County Oregon due and legal
 notice of this levy.

 being in the chair and presiding Roll Call showed
 all members of the Council present and voting
 minutes of previous meeting read and approved as read
 The Committee appointed to take care of the population
 of Lebanon. Reported that they had employed J. A.
 Reeves to do the work, by the first of January 1912
 on Motion the report was accepted

on motion the Recorder was instructed to give the
 S. P. railway Co league notice to build new side walk
 at the crossing on the East Side of Highet Street - Also
 new walk on the west Side of Braue Street at the
 railroad crossing

on Motion a New crosswalk was ordered built on
 Grant Street East of Highet Street at the most
 suitable place

on Motion the City Treasurer Bonds was placed
 at \$75,000 for the ensuing year, and the Treasurer
 be requested to divide the money received on the
 Sewer Bonds between the Two Banks on Deposit

on Motion of Councilman S M Randall and duly seconded, that \$ 825.00 be transferred from the Sewer fund to be transferred to general funds to cover the engineering fees of McClain and McArthur for \$ 425.00 and Meager and Walker \$ 400.00 in connection with Sewer Construction.
