Council met in a regular adjourned meeting with Mayor V S Wannersten in the Chair and presiding Roll Call showed all members of the Council present Mr Garland and Mr Bach were present and after stating the position of the plant regarding the light situation made the proposition to the Council to substitute 52 thirty Two candle power tungsten lights for the present 52 sixteen candle power lights, and 65¢ per month for each additional light, on motion of A E Giering the proposition of Mr Garland and Mr Bach was accepted and city attorney M M Newport was instructed to prepare an ordinance covering the same and have it ready by the next meeting.

on Motion the Marshall was ordered to make a complete list of all defective sidewalks and report at the next meeting on motion the matter of buying lumber for cross walks was referred to the Committee on Roads and Street.
