Lebanon Oregon August 20th 1912

Council met in a regular meeting Mayor G.B. Zimmerman being in the chair and presiding Roll call showed all members of the Council present except Councilman J.L. Henderwood minutes of previous meeting read and approved as read

New Business:

P.M. Sengens and L.A. Tuckett appeared before the Council and asked the Council to have oak street filled at the rail road crossing on motion it was ordered that the railroad Company be notified to put in a crossing across the track on oak and river street

Ordinance Bill No 118 ordinance 112

An Ordinance to regulate the speed of automobiles Motor vehicles Motor cycles vehicles Engines trains Cars Bicycles Carriages Street Cars and all other traveling on the Streets of the city of Lebanon within the limits of the said city

was introduced by the ordinance Committee, and read the first time

there being no opposition offered on the first reading of the Bill the mayor stated the Bill might be read now ^{second time} by title only upon the calling of the roll the vote was as follows, P.M. Crandall (yes) W.C. McLain (yes)
 J.L. Henderwood absent J.S. Northrop (yes)
 N.D. Buffhaver yes R.E. Fiering (yes)

the Bill was then read the second time by title only

whereupon the Mayor stated this is the second reading of the bill it is now ready for committee or amendment in order for the third reading

upon motion ~~made~~ of councilman McLain that the bill be read the third time now upon the calling of the Roll the vote was as follows P.M. Crandall (yes) McLain (yes)

Thereupon the Mayor Stated shall the title of the Bill stand as the title of the ordinance upon the calling of the Roll the vote was as follows Crandall (yes) McClain (yes) Underwood absent Northrop yes Steephauer yes Ziesing (yes) The Mayor then declared the title of the Bill to be the title of the ordinance The Bill was then approved by the Mayor and attested by the Recorder

Ordinance Bill No 119 ordinance No 113
an ordinance providing for the riding of Bicycles on the Sidewalks within the city limits was introduced and read the first time there being no objection offered on the first reading of the Bill the Mayor stated that the bill might be read the second time now by title only upon the calling of the roll the vote was as follows Crandall (yes) McClain yes Underwood absent Northrop yes Steephauer (yes) Ziesing (yes) the bill was then read the second time by title only the bill was then laid over until the next regular meeting.

on Motion the building of Mr Lovengood was ordered rented for one month to store the horses carts in on Motion the Marshall was ordered to have lights connected to city jail
