Report of Standing Committee

the Committee on Licenses reported favorable on the application of McCay and Hale for licenses to run a Billiard Hall within the city On Motion the Marshall was instructed to have Milton Street between Main and Second Street - worked so as to make the street in good condition

Ordinance Bill No 119 Ordinance No 113
An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of a
