Signed by several residences of Riverdale addition asking for two lights one to be placed at the intersection of Grant and Walnut Streets and one at the intersection of Ash and Walnut Streets was read and on motion was excepted and ordered placed on file.

October 15th 1912 being the time advertised for the opening of Bids for the paving of Main Street Bid from the Federal Construction Co being the only Bid, was received opened and read, and excepted by Resolution No 11
