Lebanon Oregon October 15-1912

Council met in a Regular Meeting Mayor O. S. Wimmerstein being absent on Motion Councilman J. L. Underwood was elected temporary chair of the meeting. Roll Call showed all members of the Council present except Mayor O. S. Wimmerstein.

Signed by several residences of Riverdale addition asking for two lights one to be placed at the intersection of Grant and Walnut Streets and one at the intersection of Ash and Walnut Streets was read and on Motion was accepted and ordered placed on file.

October 15th 1912 being the time advertised for the opening of Bids for the paving of Main Street. Bid from the Federal Construction Co being the only Bid received was opened and read, and accepted by Resolution No 11

Remonstrance against the paving of Main Street was read there being W. Magarty of the abutting property owners in favor of the said improvement.
