Lebanon Oregon Dec 3 1912

Council met in a regular meeting with Mayor
 V. S. Brewster in the chair and presiding Roll Call
 showed all members of the Council present
 minutes of previous meeting read and approved as read
 Petitions

asking that a regulation sidewalk be constructed on
 the south side of Grant Street abutting the property owned
 by Alb Hall was read and on motion was accepted
 and the said walk be ordered built

Petition

asking that a crosswalk be built across Grant Street
 at the corner of the cement sidewalk of the Lebanon Lumber Co
 also a crosswalk across Oak Street at the south corner
 of cement sidewalk of Lebanon Lumber Co
 was read and on motion was granted

Ordinance Bill No 120

An ordinance providing for the use of the Lebanon Sewer
 System by private individuals and the manner of con-
 necting with the same for house connections
 was introduced by the ordinance committee and read
 the first time there being no objection offered on
 the first reading of the Bill

The Mayor stated that the Bill might be read the
 second time now by title only
 upon the calling of the roll the vote was
 J. M. Brandall yes J. W. McClain (yes) J. L. Underwood yes
 J. S. Northrup yes W. D. Keefover yes A. E. Ziesing yes
 the Bill was then read by title only

whereupon the Mayor stated
 this is the second reading of the Bill it is now
 ready for commitment or amendment in order for
 the third reading the Bill was laid over until
 till the next meeting

on motion Council adjourned ^{to meet} until Friday night
 Dec 6

The Sewer Committee Reported that they had come to
 an agreement with Bidwell Hayden and Co to accept the
 completed work ^{on the sewer} and buy all the material on the ground and
 tools for the said work, and release the Bidwell Hayden
 and Co from the contract.

on motion made and duly seconded the report was accepted

Report Engineer J W McArthur
 giving the total amount due Bidwell Hayden and Co for the
 completed work done on the sewer and all material on
 the ground tools and pumps ^{to be} \$ 11,357 ⁸⁴/_{xx}

on motion of Councilman N D Keefhaver seconded
 by J S Northrop the report was accepted and ordered
 placed on file

Resolution No 12

being a Resolution to close up the contract with Bidwell
 Hayden and Co on the Lebanon Sewer System was intro-
 duced by Councilman J M Randall, and read on motion
 of A E Ziesing and duly seconded the Resolution was
 adopted as read by a unanimous vote of the Council

there being no further business to come before the meeting
 on motion Council adjourned
