Council met in regular session with Mayor Merriman in the chair. Roll call showed all Councilmen present except H. O. McClain, minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Councilman Giesing made a motion to improve South Main St. North Main St. and Grant St. and the same carried.

Motion made & carried that the City Recorder be authorized to secure the necessary registration blanks for the coming City Election.

H. C. Peterson was present and asked that the alley west of his residence be improved so that teams could go through. No action taken.

Motion made & carried that \$600⁰⁰ of the Police fund be transferred to the Road & Street fund.

Mr. Lester Stacy was present and asked that the City pay the fire boys 50¢ each when they attended a fire, and \$1⁰⁰ for the auto or team that gets to the Engine house first and hauls the hose cart.

Motion made & carried the same be granted.

Motion made & carried the Street Com. purchase a wheel cart, scoop, etc, to be used in cleaning the streets.

Motion made & carried that when the trench is cut on Sherman St. for cluster light wire that the same be cut deep enough to admit the placing of a drain pipe from the City fountain to the street. Decided by Sterling's feet store.
