

City Council Chamber

Lebanon Ore, Oct 21, 1913

Council met in regular session. In the absence of Mayor Pennersten, Councilman B. L. Cotton was elected Mayor for the evening. Roll Call showed all Councilmen present. Minutes of the adjourned and last regular meeting read and approved.

Highways & Means Committee reported that if property owners would give the street East of Mr J. C. Mayler house and build the bridge in a manner satisfactory to the Street Com. the same would be accepted by the city and kept up. by vote the report was accepted.

Moved & carried the Viewers that were appointed to assess the benefits and damages on certain Street improvements be given until our next regular meeting to report.

Recorder Burslow made his 3rd quarterly report, and the same was accepted and placed on file.

3rd Reading of ordinance

Mr Brown was present and asked the City to remove the fruit trees in the street that he had just planted no action taken except to place it in the hands of the streets Com.

By vote the Recorder was instructed to give 30 days notice of the City Election

Mr Stewart of the Electric Light & Water Co. was present and stated he could only get a guarantee of but \$3⁰⁰ per year on the new line that was ordered in North West of the High School building

By motion action was taken to rescind the ~~action~~ order of the Council previously taken

Motion made and carried that a side walk be constructed on the Westside of Williams St. South of Grant St.

Moved + carried the Street Committee be given power to improve the street around the Combinations feed Barn
