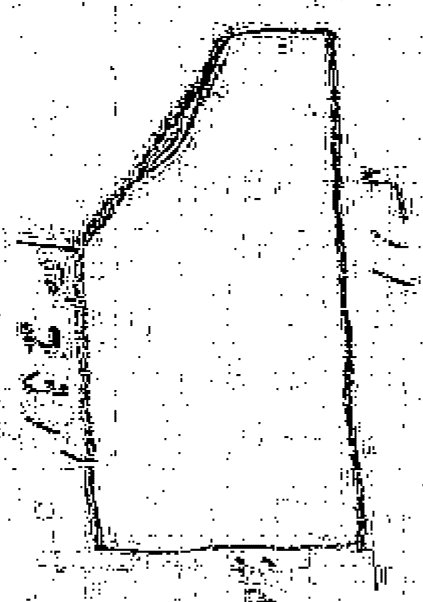

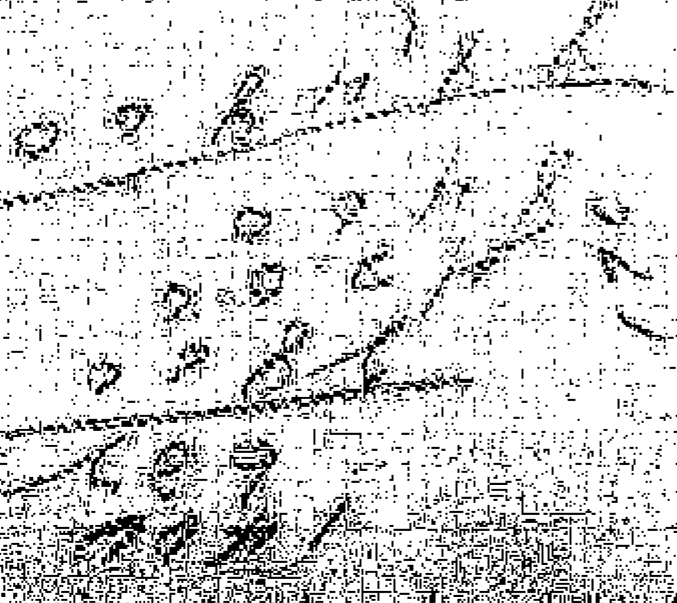

Lebanon, Ore., Dec. 2, 1913.

Council met in regular meeting in the absence of Mayor Munro, H. O. McClain was elected Mayor Pro. tem. Roll call showed all Councilmen present. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

City Attorney introduced and read Ordinance ^{Bill} # 150 Ordinance # an ordinance authorizing and directing the issuance and sale of improvement bonds of the City of Lebanon Lin. Co. Ore. for the improvement of Main St. from ~~the~~ A Street to the south line of Caroline St. by paving the same with Gravel Bitulithic Pavement, in accordance with the Charter of the said City and the provisions of Section 3245 to 3253 inclusive, of Chapter 5 of Title XXVI of Laws of Oregon, and acts amendatory thereof, in the sum of \$16,500.00, the same being the total amount of the unpaid assessments for such improvements of said street for which applications to pay in installments have been filed with the recorder of the said City of Lebanon, and there being no objection to the first reading of the bill.
