

My Council Chamber, Lebanon, Dec, 1886 / 7 / 14.

Council called to order by Mayor Conner.
Roll call showed all members present.
The minutes of the previous meeting were
read and approved.

Mr. McArthur reported that the street signs
were ordered and will arrive in the near
future. He also reported having filled the
joint between the concrete and asphaltic pave-
ment on Grant St. at the point where Grant St. is
intersected by Park St.

Records reported the following monies having
been received since last meeting:

L.H. Doolittle \$5.; F.J. Daly \$6. Geo. Powell 75c. A. T. Quincy
estate 150.75 John Keph 5c. Ted Daly, 15c. Mrs. Bishop 52c.
J.R. Green 5c.

Street Dept. Mr. Green reported as to the building
of sidewalks ordered built, that most of the walk-
es ordered are either built, or preparations are
being made to have them built.

There was some discussion as to the walk
running East and West by Dr. Lewis' residence. Mr.
Cotton made a motion that Dr. Lewis be permitted
to wait until Spring before building the sidewalk.
Motion lost for want of a second.

The matter plumber's license was also
discussed. Motion by Mr. Northrop that a com-
mittee be appointed to serve as an Examining
Board, to examine credentials of plumbers before
a license is issued. Seconded. Motion carries.
Major appointed Amos, Blackburn and Northrop
as Examining Board.

A petition for a light on the corner of
Oak & Hill Sts. was, upon motion, referred to
the Street Com.

A Resolution regarding the widening of
Franklin St. was read by the City Engineer.
The resolution was duly adopted.

Dr. Amos brought up the question of
changing the name of Grant St. to Bridge St.
Object was made to the change on the
ground that such a change might cause

confusion.

Upon motion the Treasurer was directed to pay the City's bills for street ^{parc} improvements on Main St.

Motion by Blackburn that notice be published that plumber license will expire Dec 1st, and that all who would take out ^{new} licence must apply to the Surveyor Board. Motion carries.

RESOLUTION

Regarding the Widening and Extension of Franklin Street.

WHEREAS, Franklin Street, in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, as at present established is only twenty (20) feet wide from the center of Elmore Street, South to the terminus of said Franklin Street; and,

WHEREAS, the Common Council of said City deems it expedient and for the best interests of said City, that said Franklin Street be laid out and widened to the width of fifty (50) feet, from the center line of said Elmore Street, South to the present terminus of said Franklin Street, and that it be further extended, and laid out and opened, fifty (50) feet in width, from its present Southern terminus, South to an intersection with the County Road at the City Limits; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON:

That the City Engineer of said City be, and he is hereby directed and authorized to make a survey of said part of Franklin Street above mentioned, and of the above mentioned extension of the same, laying out the same to a width of fifty (50) feet for the entire length thereof from the center line of Elmore Street, South to the City Limits, and marking the boundaries thereof; and, further, to make a plat of the same and a written report containing a full and complete description of such street and change, and of the boundaries thereof, and of the portions of each lot and tract of land to be appropriated therefor, and to file said plat and report with the City Recorder within thirty (30) days from the date of this resolution.

Adopted by unanimous vote of the Council, and approved by the Mayor, this 17th day of November, 1914.
