A Ordinance Bill — fixing and levying an assessment upon the several lots, parcels and tracts of land specially benefited by the improvement of that part of Grand Street in the City of Lebanon, Oregon, extending from the W. curb line of Park St. Eastward to the City limits, was introduced and read in full for the first time. There being no objection the bill was read the second time by title only.

The ordinance bill was not read the third time by reason of the absence of Councilman Northrop.

There was considerable discussion as to the sidewalk in front of the Elkine property on N. Main St., but no definite action was taken.
