

City Council Chamber, Lebanon, Va.

Sept. 7, 1915.

Council met in regular session. All members of the Council present. Dr. Amos was chosen Mayor pro tem.

Ordinance Bill # 23 - "An Ordinance to regulate the height of awnings" - was introduced and read in full for the first time. There being no objection the bill was read the second time by title only. On motion of Mr. Blackburn the bill was ordered published before being read the third time.

Marshall asked for sprinklers for use on N. Main St. before polling street. On motion of Mr. Ingram the St. Dept. was ordered to get a sprinkler.

The need of a new hose for washing streets was called to the ^{attention of} Councilmen. The matter was referred to the Com. on Streets and Public Property, ^{with power to act}.

Marshall asked permission to use old hose cart in washing streets. On motion of Mr. Ingram permission was granted.

Mr. Jones and Mr. Taylor reported that the City would be unable to get crushed rock from Mr. Hall, for N. Main St.

Upon motion of Mr. Blackburn the Mayor was authorized to appoint a committee with power to act, to interview County Court in regard to getting rock from the Hall crushed.

Mayor appointed Blackburn, Taylor, Wallace, Reece, Jones and Moist.

Street Dept. reported that pipe for drains on N. Main St. would be necessary. Mayor suggested that the matter be left to the Street Comm., with power to act.

The following bills were allowed and warrants ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the amounts: Light Water Co. \$26.12; J. J. Bishop \$66.00; H. E. Smith \$65.00; Alfred Good \$25.00.

Balance of bills referred to Finance Com. There being no further business the Council adjourned.
