

City Council Chamber, Lebanon, Ore, Oct 19<sup>th</sup> 15

Council met in regular session, Mayor Council presiding. All members of the Council present. Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

The Quarterly Report of the Recorder was read and referred to the Finance Com.

Dr Wright of the Fire Dept. called attention to the fact that certain hose couplings were badly needed. The matter was referred to the Com. on Streets and Public Property.

A communication from the Mayor reporting the results of his investigations into the Office of City Marshall was read. Upon motion the report was received and placed on file.

Mr Wallace made a motion that the office of City Marshall be declared vacant. The motion was <sup>seconded and</sup> amended by Dr. Kimmell, and inconspicuously was none as the cause of declaring the office vacant.

There followed considerable discussion. A vote by aye and nay was called for and the result was as follows:

Ingram, no; Amos, no; Blackburn, no; Kimmell, yes; Gayle, no; Wallace, yes.

Dr. Amos made a motion, which was duly seconded, that that matter of complaint against the Marshall be investigated Monday evening Oct 25<sup>th</sup> 15. Motion carried.

A petition asking for a "Seven Fire Alarm System" was read and placed on file.

Estimates of expenditures in the various Departments of the City of Lebanon for the coming year was read in full.

Dr Amos made a motion that \$500 be placed on the Budget for the Library with the understanding that if in the next election the people refused to sanction it the amount should be used to reduce the indebtedness of the City. Motion carried.

On motion of Dr. Amos \$500 was placed on Budget for Street Cleaning apparatus.

On motion of Mr. Blackburn the Budget appropriations were accepted tentatively, and that the same <sup>be</sup> published.

On motion of Dr Amos the Treasurer and Recorder were instructed to provide a "Sinking Fund" for Sewer Bonds, out of tax money received.

The Council extended a vote of thanks for the work done on Wheeler St.

Motion by Dr Amos that attention be called to the loose boards of sidewalk near South School, also to the pile of gravel in the street near rail road Mutual Carriage.

The "Fire Dept." Com., directed to collect from Lebanon Lumber Co a certain bill, was relieved, and the Recorder was instructed to present the matter to the company.
