

City Council Chamber, Lebanon, Ore, Oct 25 '15

Council met in adjourned session, pursuant
of adjournment of Oct 19th. All members of the
Council present. Mayor presided.

The Mayor's report of investigation of office
of City Marshall was read in full.

Marshall Bishop presented his defense, exhibiting
receipts, memoranda etc.

A general discussion on the part of
councilmen followed.

Motion by Dr. Amos that future St. Supt.,

received and paid. Motion carried.

Bishop be reinstated. A vote taken by aye
and nay resulted as follows:—

Ingraw, yes; Amos, yes; Blackburn, yes;
Kimmell, no; Gayton, yes; Wallace, no.
