City Council Chamber Lebanon Ore. Nov. 27, 1915

The Council met in special session in pursuant to call, with all members of the council present and in their places and the mayor in the chair and presiding,

The matter of the annual budget for the fiscal year of 1916 was taken up and discussed, and the tax levy for the year 1916 was fixed at 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills by resolution, and the following resolution and budget of expenditures was unanimously adopted for the said fiscal year of 1916, for the city of Lebanon.

RESOLUTION NO. 19, for 1915.

Resolution adopting a Budget of Expenditures for the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year 1916 and making and fixing the Tax Levy for the said Year to meet the said Expenditures.

WHEREAS, It Is Necessary that funds be raised to meet the expenditures of the government of the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, for the fiscal year of 1916, and to pay the interest in the bonded debts of the said city, and to pay the salary of the officers of the said city for the said year, and other general expenses of the said City, including the repair of streets and crosswalks of the said city for the said year, and

Whereas, the Common Council of the said City has adopted a budget system for the said City as by law required, Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON,
LINN COUNTY, OREGON,

That the following be, and the same is hereby adopted as the budget of expenditures for the City of Lebanon, in Linn County, State of Oregon, for the fiscal year 1916, and that the several amounts therein named shall be and are hereby appropriated for the several and respective purposes and objects therein named and specified, as follows:-

And be it further resolved, that no city officer or head of any department of the City government shall during the said fiscal year 1916, incur any debt, liability or obligation on behalf of the City of Lebanon against any of the said accounts which in the aggregate shall exceed the amount herein appropriated for his department or office, unless the council, shall first specifically authorized such additional expenditure or liability or obligation, and shall have made provision for the payment thereof. And

WHEREAS, It is Necessary to meet the said appropriation and expenditures, and to pay the said general expenses of the said city, and the salary of the said officers and to pay the said interest and other expenses of the said city as enumerated in the said city budget, that in addition to the other revenue and moneys of the said city moneys be raised by general taxation, on all the taxable property of the said City, Now.

Therefore Be It Further Resolved, by the said Common Council of the said City of Lebanon, in Linn County, Oregon, that for the purpose of meeting the said expenditures of the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, for the said fiscal year 1916, and to pay the general and other expenses of the said City, and the salary of the officers thereof, and the interest of the bonded and other debts of the said City and for the repair of the streets and crosswalks of the said city and other necessary expenses of the said City, that there be, and there is hereby levied upon each one Dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property in the said City of Lebanon, Oregon, as shown by the County assessment roll of said Linn County now on file with the officers of the said County as made by the County Assessor of the said County, for the year 1915, the sum of 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ mills on the one Dollars of the said roll, the same to be collected as by law provided.

And Be It Further resolved that the recorder of the City of Lebanon, at once notify the County Clerk of Linn County, Oregon, in writing of the levy hereby made, and transmit to him a certified copy of this

Resolution on or before the 1st day of December, 1915.

On motion of Councilman Amos the city firemen were allowed the free use of the band instruments owned by the City, .

The City Attorney was instructed to investigate and report to the council security offered for the sinking funds of the city, and to look up desirable security and loan for the said funds.

On Motion of councilman Crandall, the street superintendent was directed to build cross walks only to curb line and the abutting property owners build their side walks out to the curb line, on all street where new cross walks are put in.

S. O. Was was duly elected as acting recorder of the City of Lebanon during the absence of the recorder from the City.

No further business coming before the council the Council duly adjourned.
