

City Council Chambers Lebanon Oregon Aug 1<sup>st</sup> 1916

Council met in regular session,  
Mayor Underwood presiding,  
all members of Council present;  
Minutes of last regular meeting read  
and approved.

Councilman H. M. Reeves chairman  
of special Committee appointed to confer  
with County Court submitted a verbal  
report.

The City Treasurer R. Wayne Green  
submitted his Semiannual report,  
which on motion of Mr. Skimmell was  
received and ordered placed on file.

Ordinance No. 209  
An ordinance to authorize the purchase  
of certain fire apparatus and fire equipment  
for the City of Lebanon Oregon, was introduced  
and read the first time in full.

There being no objections, read the second  
time by Title only.

The bill being now ready for commitment  
or amendment in order for a third reading.

The Mayor stated: Shall the bill be read  
the third time?

Upon the roll being called and the  
vote taken by Aye and Nay all members of  
the Council voting in the Affirmative.

The bill was therefore read the third time in full.  
Question now being, Shall the bill pass?

The vote being taken by Aye & Nay the  
result was as follows, Wilson yes, H. M. Reeves yes,  
Mr. Skimmell yes, A. M. Reeves yes, Crandall yes.  
The bill was therefore declared duly enacted  
and passed.

By unanimous <sup>vote</sup> of the Council the  
Title of the bill was made the Title of the ordinance.
