

## City Council Chambers Oct. 13-1916.

Council met in regular session,  
Mayor Underwood presiding.

All members of the Council present.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.  
Fire Chief R. L. Gilson submitted his  
report - which was read and ordered placed  
on file.

The Mayor appointed Councilman H. H.  
Reeves and W. W. Kimmell on the Budget  
Committee.

Councilman Crandall brought up  
the question of graveling the recently graded  
parts of Ash and Vine Streets.

After some discussion of the matter,  
and on motion of H. H. Reeves the City Atty.  
was instructed to prepare a petition for  
subscription for graveling said streets by  
the property adjacent thereto.

Fire Chief Gilson addressed the Council  
on the subject of "Fire protection", referring  
to his experience in having the moss  
removed from the roof of the various buildings  
in the City; and also the needs of a better  
Fire Alarm system and recommended the  
purchase of a 2000 lbs. Bell.

After some considerable discussion of  
the matter of purchasing a new Bell it  
was decided by motion of H. H. Reeves to  
instruct the Fire Chief to have the covering  
removed from the Fire Bell and make such  
other repairs as is necessary for increasing  
the efficiency of the present Fire Alarm  
system. The following bills were read and on mo-  
tion of A. J. Crandall were ordered paid.
