

City Council Chambers Dec 19-1916

Council met in regular session, Mayor Underwood presiding. All members of the Council present. Minutes of last regular meeting read and approved.

The Canvassing Board submitted their report. On motion of A. J. Crandall the report was adopted and ordered placed on file. On motion of H. M. Reeves the City Atty. was instructed to prepare an ordinance fixing the salary of the City Recorder. H. A. Reeves made a statement submitting a proposition from the owners of Yeoman Hall to rent to the City, said Hall to be used as a City Hall and controlled by the City Council; for one year with the privilege of five years at the rate of (\$20) Twenty Dollars per month; the same to be paid by the month.

After a thorough discussion of the matter, A. J. Crandall moved a resolution authorizing the City Council to enter into contract with the owners of said Yeoman Hall for the rent of the same.

On motion of A. J. Crandall the Trustees of the City Library were tendered the use of the "dining room" of Yeoman Hall for Library purposes rent free.
