

Lebanon Ore Sept 18<sup>th</sup> 1916

Council met in regular session  
Mayor J. L. Underwood presiding  
Left members of Council present:  
Minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved

City Attorney made verbal report of survey  
in North west part of the City.

Work on Oak Street was left to committee  
on streets and public property.

Attention was called to petition presented  
to Council in 1916: for lights on Mary Street  
On motion two lights were allowed for said  
street one at the intersection of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street  
and one at Third Street

J. V. Currico presented request for the erasure  
of the name of A. H. Evers from the Police  
booklet and the return of Ten Dollars bail  
money: that had been declared forfeited.  
Council recommended that, if desired, by  
Mr Evers, the Recorder be advised to re-  
open the case and give him a trial on  
the merits of the case.

On motion by W. M. Reeves the Office of City  
Health Officer was declared vacant on account  
of absence of Dr. Miller from the state  
and Council proceeded to elect his successor.  
On Ballot vote Dr. Basendrick received  
six votes: a unanimous vote and was  
declared elected Health Officer for the Balance  
of the term.

On motion of Dr. Kimmel, the Street Com-  
missioner was instructed to have tree on  
Oak Street on J. C. P. Manup property removed  
at once.

ordered drawn on the Treasurer for the amounts:
