

Lebanon Ore. Aug 20th 1918

Council met in regular session. Mayor J. L. Underwood presiding. All members of the Council present. Committee of Streets and Public Property reported that bridge across Canal on Grove Street was in bad condition and should be replaced at once and that it would require some 9,000 feet of Lumber to construct same.

On motion the report was accepted and referred back to Committee with power to act.

On motion the Committee was instructed to proceed with the construction of a Concrete Bridge across the Canal down main Street. According to Plans and specifications furnished by the Engineer of the State Highway Commission.
