Ord Bill # 9
An Ordinance amending portions of A Street
and certain Alleys in Center addition in
the City of Lebanon; in favor of the Oregon
and California R R Co was read the first
time in full, and on roll call was passed
all members of the council voting yes.

Was read the second time by title only
and on roll call was passed unanimously.
Was read the third time in full and
on roll call, passed all members voting
yes.

There being no objection the title
of the bill, was declared to be the title
of the Ordinance.

Ord Bill # 10
An Ordinance authorizing and instructing
the Mayor and City Recorder to sign Deeds
conveying title to Portions of A Street and
Chestnut Alley in Center Addition to Lebanon

from the City of Lebanon to the Oregon and California RR Co was read the first time in full. and on roll call was passed all members voting yes.

Was read the second time by title only and on roll call passed, all members voting yes.

Was read the third time in full and on roll call, passed all members voting yes.

There being no objections the title of the bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance.
