Ordinance Bill # 9 for 1918. Ordinance # 228 An Ordinance vacating portions of A Streets and certain Alleys in Center Addition in the City of Lebanon; in favor of the Oregon and California R R Co was read the first time in full, and on roll call was passed all members of the council voting yes;

Was read the second time by title only and on roll call was passed unanimously.

Was read the third time in full and on roll call, passed. all members voting aye;

There being no objection the Title of the bill, was declared to be the title of the Ordinance
