of Correspondence, the Column at corner  
of Third and Sherman Streets had been  
paid for. No report on Column at corner  
of 2nd and Sherman Streets.

On motion Mr Kuhn was allowed a rebate  
on his license for moving Picture Show,  
for the time he was closed on account of  
the influenza Run.

Ordinance Bill #12 for 1918. Ordinance #231.  
"No 231 An Ordinance Authorizing the payment to  
Linn Co. of a bill for \$278<sup>75</sup> for Grading  
and putting Gravel on Langensh Street. A  
bill for \$75<sup>00</sup> previously advanced by the County  
on purchase of Gravel Bar, was read  
the first time in full, and on roll call  
was passed unanimously, all members  
of the Council voting yes.

Was read the 2<sup>nd</sup> time by title only  
and passed.

Was read the third time in full, and  
on roll call passed, all members of the  
Council present voting yes.

There being no objection the title of the  
Bill was declared to be the title of the  
Ordinance.

Ordinance #232, laid over from previous  
meeting was read in full the third  
time and amended. And on roll call  
was passed unanimously, all members  
of the Council present, voting yes.
