

Lebanon Ore Sept 16th 1919.

Council met in regular session with Mayor Millsaps presiding.

All members of the Council present.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Remonstrance against the vacation of a portion of 4th Street was read and on motion was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Res # 14

Resolving of the City Engineer Plans and Estimates for the improvement of parts of Park Street and part of Ash Street, was read and on roll call was adopted all members of the Council voting yes.

Res # 15

Resolution # 15 for 1919 approving plans and specification for the improvement of Park Street from Grand Street to Sherman Street, and from Ash Street to Vine Street; and Ash Street between Main Street and 2nd Street, was read and on roll call was adopted all members of the Council voting yes.

Resolution # 16

Resolution # 16, Declaring intention and purpose of improving Park and Ash Street in the City of Lebanon and estimates of the cost of the same was read, and on roll call was adopted all members of the Council voting yes.

Ord bill # 11

For 1919 and Ordinance vacating 4th Street between Oak Street and Maple Street, was read the first time in July; and on roll call was ordered read the second time by title only: all members of the Council voting yes: On the question shall the bill be read the Third time, the vote on roll call was. B L Cotton, yes; M Burtenshaw, yes; A J Corradell, yes; S O Wallace, No; L A Tucker, yes; J W Stimmel, No: there being objection to the Third reading and passage of the bill it was laid over until next meeting.

On motion of B L Cotton duly recorded, the Bond of the City Treasurer, was placed at Five Thousand dollars (\$5000) and that the City pay the Premium on a Curity Bond.

On motion of J M Burtenshaw, the Paper Mill Co was requested to repair Flume

under the Rail Road used as a switch
to the mill:

On motion of J O Wallace. The Ordinance Com.
was instructed to prepare an Ordinance repealing
all Ordinances, relating to Parking automobiles
on the City Streets:
