Council met in regular session

Mayor Byron Miller presiding

All members of the Council present

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved

Petition of Celysis favoring vacating of a part of 4th Street was read and ordered placed on file.

Communication from the Civic Club in regard to establishing a camping ground for tourists was read and placed on file.

On motion of H H Kimmel duly seconded a committee was appointed to confer with the Civic Club and with the Garage and other business men, in regard to establishing such a place.

The Mayor appointed J O Wallace to H H Kimmel & B L Cotton as such a committee.

Ord bill #11 Vacating 4th Street between Oak St and Maple Street was read in full the third time, and on roll call the vote was as follows:

There being a majority of the Council voting yes the bill was declared passed.

There being no objection the title of the bill was declared to be the title of the Ordinance.
