Council met in regular session: in Office of City Attorney Newport.

Mr. Kemmel of the committee on Tourist Camp ground, reported that the business men appeared lukewarm when approached on the subject, and that the Budget committee would make an effort to take care of the matter in the Budget:

The Report of the Recorder for the third quarter and a summary of expenses for the three quarters of 1919, was read and placed on file:

Communication from E H Jones in regard to locating a mill at Lebanon, was read and placed on file.

The Superintendent of Streets, reported that the sidewalk abutting the Mesarvey property, on East Grand Street, was in bad condition and should be rebuilt: that a new walk was necessary:

A motion was made that the owners of the property be notified to build a cement walk forthwith: Motion carried.

The Superintendent of Streets was instructed to make a written report of the Sidewalks that need repairing or rebuilding in all parts of the City:

The Budget Committee submitted a report: and after discussion, and several amendments, the following was adopted as a Tentative Budget, July 1920: and Nov 17th 1919 at 7³⁰ P.M. in the City Hall: as the time and place for holding a mass meeting of the citizens of Lebanon to discuss the same

On motion of B L Cotton the Leb & L Water Co were ordered to repair hydrants where necessary; at once, and on failure on their part to do so, the Supt of Streets was authorized to repair same, and charge all costs to the E & L Water Co:
